

Changes to train times

This week - Monday 20 to Friday 24 January

Urgent repairs to the track in the Ladywell area

Damage has been discovered to the track near Ladywell. Our partners at Network Rail advise that a specialist part is required, which isn't immediately available and needs to be specially produced. Until the repairs have been completed, we need to make some temporary changes as follows on the Hayes line in order to continue to run the same number of trains on the route. Some trains are not stopping at Eden Park or New Beckenham, however during the weekday evening "peck" period from London, trains will stop at all stations as usual.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday

- 08 and 38 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hayes services will depart as scheduled, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge and will then be diverted to call at Ladywell and all stations to Hayes, except for New Beckenham and Eden Park, arriving at Hayes at 23 and 53 minutes past the hour.
- 14 and 44 minutes past the hour Hayes to Charing Cross services, will run from Orpington at 17 and 47 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Hither Green, then London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross. Replacement bus services will run from Hayes, calling at all stations to Lewisham and then London Bridge.

Please see below for alterations during the weekend.

Engineering work will affect the following late night services:

Long term alterations:

- Mondays from 2345** - Ashford to Minster via Canterbury West line is closed. Replacement bus services will run from Ashford and alternative train services to Ramsgate only.
- Tuesdays from 2325** - Faversham to Ramsgate via Heme Bay line is closed. Replacement bus services will run from Faversham and alternative train services to Ramsgate only.
- Mondays and Tuesdays from 2340** - Charing Cross to London Bridge line is closed. Train services will run from Cannon Street.
- Wednesdays and Thursdays from 2345** - Cannon Street to London Bridge line is closed. Train services will run from Charing Cross.

Monday only

- 2339 Cannon Street to Dover Priory will run, calling at London Bridge, Ashford International, Folkestone West(s), Folkestone Central(s) and Dover Priory. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at Padlock Wood(s), Marden(s), Staplehurst(s), Headcorn, Pluckley(s) and Ashford International.
- 0010 London Bridge to Gravesend replacement bus service will run, calling at Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, Charlton, all stations to Slade Green, Dartford and all stations(s) to Gravesend.

Monday and Tuesday only

- 2348 Cannon Street to Hastings will terminate at Tunbridge Wells. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at Wadhurst(s), Battle(s), West St Leonards(s), St Leonards Warrior Square(s) and Hastings. A replacement minibus service will run between Battle and Crowhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at all stations(s) to Robertsbridge.
- 0026 Cannon Street to Dartford will run, calling at London Bridge, Lewisham and all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath. A replacement bus service will run from London Bridge, calling at Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, Charlton, all stations(s) to Slade Green, Dartford and all stations(s) to Gravesend.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday only

- 2245 Charing Cross to Hastings will not call at Frant, Wadhurst, Stonegate, Etchingham, Robertsbridge, Battle, Crowhurst and West St Leonards. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at Wadhurst(s), Battle(s) and West St Leonards. A replacement minibus service will run between Battle and Crowhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at all stations(s) to Robertsbridge.

Monday, Wednesday and Thursday only

- 0010 Tonbridge to Headcorn replacement bus service will run, calling at Padlock Wood, Marden, Staplehurst and Headcorn.
- 0122 Headcorn to Ashford International replacement bus service will run, calling at Pluckley(s) and Ashford International.

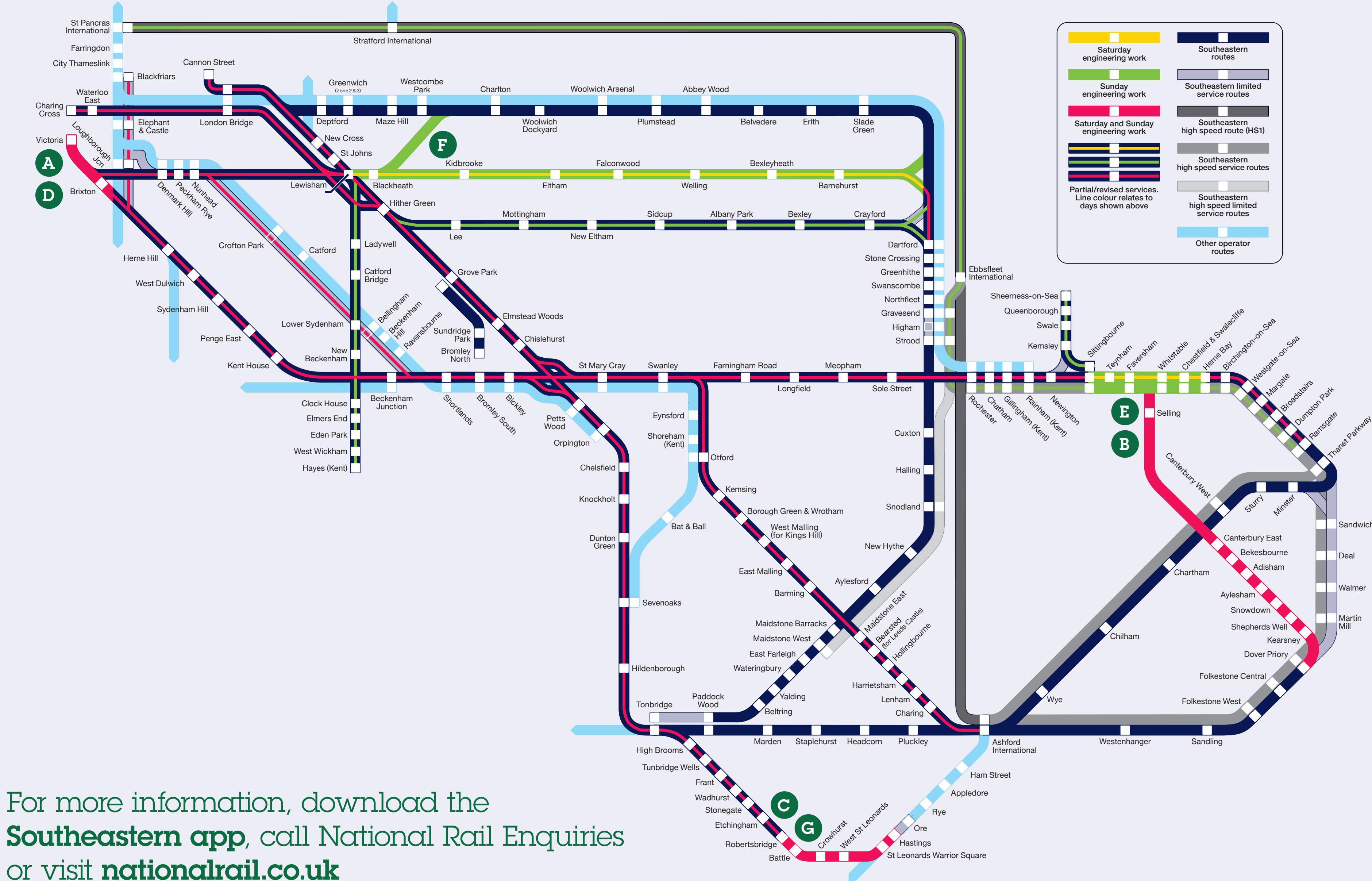
Wednesday and Thursday only

- 2234 Charing Cross to Ramsgate will terminate at Minster. A replacement bus service will run from Minster, calling at Thanet Parkway(s) and Ramsgate.

- 2307 St Pancras International to Ramsgate will terminate at Tunbridge Wells. A replacement bus service will run from Deal, calling at Sandwich(s) and Ramsgate.
- 2334 Charing Cross to Canterbury West will run, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Ashford International(s), Wye(s), Chilham(s), Chartham(s) and Canterbury West. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at Padlock Wood(s), Marden(s), Staplehurst(s), Headcorn, Pluckley(s) and Ashford International.
- 2340 St Pancras International to Margate will call additionally and terminate at Minster. A replacement bus service will run from Minster, calling at Thanet Parkway(s), Ramsgate, Broadstairs(s) and Margate.
- 2345 Charing Cross to Hastings will terminate at Tunbridge Wells. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at Wadhurst(s), Battle(s), West St Leonards(s), St Leonards Warrior Square(s) and Hastings. A replacement minibus service will run between Battle and Crowhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at all stations(s) to Robertsbridge.
- 0020 Lewisham to Gravesend replacement bus service will run, calling at Blackheath, all stations to Slade Green, Dartford and all stations(s) to Gravesend.
- 0022 Charing Cross to Dartford will run, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Lewisham and all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath. A replacement bus service will run from Lewisham, calling at Blackheath, Charlton, all stations to Slade Green(s), Dartford(s) and all stations(s) to Gravesend.

- A replacement bus service will run from Sittingbourne, calling at Faversham, Whitstable, Cheshfield & Swalecliffe and Heme Bay. Train services will depart from Heme Bay at 05 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Ramsgate.
- A replacement bus service will run from Sittingbourne, calling at Faversham and Canterbury East only. A replacement bus service will run from Canterbury East to Dover Priory. A replacement minibus service will run from Sittingbourne, calling at Teynham, Faversham and Selling. A replacement bus service will run from Canterbury East, calling at all stations to Dover Priory.

F Engineering work is taking place between Nunhead/New Cross and Charing Cross/Dartford via Blackheath/Bexleyheath on Sunday 26 January

- 03 and 33 minutes past the hour Victoria to Dartford via Bexleyheath services, **will not run**. A replacement bus service will run from New Cross, calling at Lewisham and all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath. To connect with the above replacement bus service, please travel on the 15 and 45 minutes past the hour train service from Cannon Street.
- 01 and 31 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Sevenoaks services, will not call at Lewisham.
- 06 and 36 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Dartford via Sidcup services, will not call at Lewisham.
- 18 and 48 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hayes services, will be diverted after London Bridge, calling at Hither Green and then all stations to Orpington. Replacement bus services will run from London Bridge, calling at Lewisham and all stations to Hayes.
- 15 and 45 minutes past the hour Cannon Street via Bexleyheath services, will call at London Bridge, New Cross, St Johns, Hither Green and all stations to Slade Green via Sidcup.
