Monday 23 December

A scheduled Saturday service will operate on all Southeastern routes with the following alterations:

- 1615, 1715, 1815 and 1915 Charing Cross to Hastings services, will call additionally at all stations from Tunbridge Wells to Hastings.
- Train services will depart from Cannon Street at 1641, 1711 and 1741 calling at London Bridge, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne, Faversham and all stations to Ramsgate.
- A train service will depart from St Pancras International at 1750, calling at Stratford International, Ebbsfleet International, Gravesend, Strood, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne and Faversham.
- 0502 Ramsgate to St Pancras International, will depart at 0455, calling at all stations to Ashford International and then run as scheduled.
- 0519 Tonbridge to Charing Cross will depart at 0445, calling additionally at Hildenborough and Chelsfield.
- 0528 Hayes to Charing Cross, will depart at 0514 and run earlier throughout.
- A train service will depart from London Bridge at 0600, calling at Cannon Street only.
- 0600 Faversham to St Pancras International will start from Broadstairs at 0527, calling additionally at Margate, Birchington-on-Sea, Heme Bay and Whitstable, and then run as scheduled from Faversham.
- Train services will depart from Ramsgate at 0527, 0605 and 0627, calling at all stations to Faversham, then Sittingbourne, Rainham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- A train service will depart from Faversham at 0930, calling at Sittingbourne, Rainham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, Strood, Gravesend, Ebbsfleet International, Stratford International and St Pancras International.
- 0614 and 0714 Maidstone East to Charing Cross services, will start from Ashford International at 0544 and 0640, calling at all stations to Maidstone East and then run as scheduled.
- 0631, 0731 and 0831 Hastings to Charing Cross services, will depart earlier at 0620, 0720 and 0820, calling at all stations to Tonbridge and then run as scheduled.

After 2300 some Charing Cross services will to start and finish at Cannon Street.

Tuesday 24 December - Christmas Eve

A scheduled Saturday service will operate on all Southeastern routes with the following alterations:

- 1615, 1715, 1815 and 1915 Charing Cross to Hastings services, will call additionally at all stations from Tunbridge Wells to Hastings.
- Train services will depart from Cannon Street at 1641, 1711 and 1741 calling at London Bridge, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne, Faversham and all stations to Ramsgate.
- A train service will depart from St Pancras International at 1750, calling at Stratford International, Ebbsfleet International, Gravesend, Strood, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne and Faversham.
- 0502 Ramsgate to St Pancras International, will depart at 0455, calling at all stations to Ashford International and then run as scheduled.
- 0519 Tonbridge to Charing Cross will depart at 0445, calling additionally at Hildenborough and Chelsfield.
- 0528 Hayes to Charing Cross, will depart at 0514 and run earlier throughout.
- A train service will depart from London Bridge at 0600, calling at Cannon Street only.
- 0600 Faversham to St Pancras International will start from Broadstairs at 0527, calling additionally at Margate, Birchington-on-Sea, Heme Bay and Whitstable, and then run as scheduled from Faversham.
- Train services will depart from Ramsgate at 0527, 0605 and 0627, calling at all stations to Faversham, then Sittingbourne, Rainham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- A train service will depart from Faversham at 0930, calling at Sittingbourne, Rainham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, Strood, Gravesend, Ebbsfleet International, Stratford International and St Pancras International.
- 0614 and 0714 Maidstone East to Charing Cross services, will start from Ashford International at 0544 and 0640, calling at all stations to Maidstone East and then run as scheduled.
- 0631, 0731 and 0831 Hastings to Charing Cross services, will depart earlier at 0620, 0720 and 0820, calling at all stations to Tonbridge and then run as scheduled.

All Southeastern services, will shut down earlier, with a reduced frequency from 2100 and no trains running after 2200.

Thursday 26 December - Boxing Day

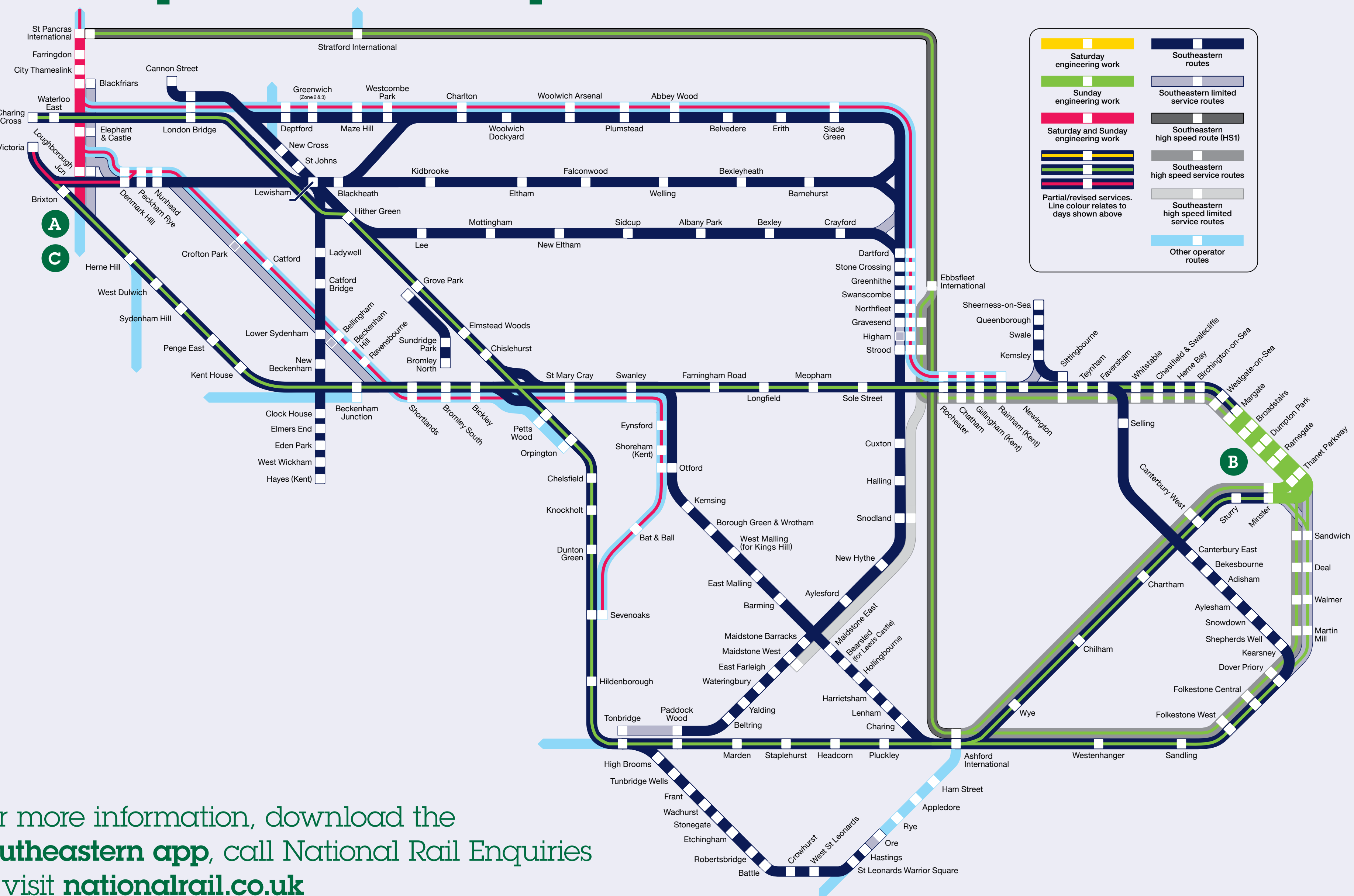

- 1615, 1715, 1815 and 1915 Charing Cross to Hastings services, will call additionally at all stations from Tunbridge Wells to Hastings.
- Train services will depart from Cannon Street at 1641, 1711 and 1741 calling at London Bridge, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne, Faversham and all stations to Ramsgate.
- A train service will depart from St Pancras International at 1750, calling at Stratford International, Ebbsfleet International, Gravesend, Strood, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne and Faversham.
- 0502 Ramsgate to St Pancras International, will depart at 0455, calling at all stations to Ashford International and then run as scheduled.
- 0519 Tonbridge to Charing Cross will depart at 0445, calling additionally at Hildenborough and Chelsfield.
- 0528 Hayes to Charing Cross, will depart at 0514 and run earlier throughout.
- A train service will depart from London Bridge at 0600, calling at Cannon Street only.
- 0600 Faversham to St Pancras International will start from Broadstairs at 0527, calling additionally at Margate, Birchington-on-Sea, Heme Bay and Whitstable, and then run as scheduled from Faversham.
- Train services will depart from Ramsgate at 0527, 0605 and 0627, calling at all stations to Faversham, then Sittingbourne, Rainham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- A train service will depart from Faversham at 0930, calling at Sittingbourne, Rainham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, Strood, Gravesend, Ebbsfleet International, Stratford International and St Pancras International.
- 0614 and 0714 Maidstone East to Charing Cross services, will start from Ashford International at 0544 and 0640, calling at all stations to Maidstone East and then run as scheduled.
- 0631, 0731 and 0831 Hastings to Charing Cross services, will depart earlier at 0620, 0720 and 0820, calling at all stations to Tonbridge and then run as scheduled.

Saturday 28 December

A scheduled Saturday service will operate on all Southeastern routes, with the following Thameslink alterations:

A Engineering work is taking place between St Pancras International and Heme Hill on Saturday 28 December

- 17 and 47 minutes past the hour Luton to Rainham Thameslink services, will start from London Bridge at 18 and 48 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled.
- 16 and 46 minutes past the hour Blackfriars to Sevenoaks Thameslink services, will start from Victoria at 15 and 45 minutes past the hour, calling at Denmark Hill and then run as scheduled.
- 28 and 58 minutes past the hour Rainham to Luton Thameslink services, will terminate at London Bridge.
- 22 and 52 minutes past the hour Sevenoaks to Blackfriars Thameslink services, will run as scheduled to Denmark Hill and then be diverted to terminate at Victoria.

Sunday 29 December

B Engineering work is taking place between Margate and Minster on Sunday 29 December

- 40 minutes past the hour St Pancras International to Margate via Canterbury West services, will call as scheduled to Canterbury West and then terminate at Minster. A replacement bus service will run from Minster, calling at all stations to Margate.
- 07 minutes past the hour St Pancras International to Ramsgate services, will terminate at Dover Priory.
- 20 minutes past the hour St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Faversham services, will terminate at Margate. A replacement bus service will run from Margate, calling at Broadstairs and Ramsgate.
- 40 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ramsgate services, will terminate at Margate.
- A replacement bus service will run from Margate, calling at all stations to Ramsgate.
- 04 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Dover Priory services, will call additionally at Pluckley and on arrival at Ashford International the train will divide:
 - The front portion will depart at 28 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Minster via Dover Priory.
 - The rear portion will depart at 30 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Minster via Canterbury West.
- A replacement bus service will run from Minster, calling at Ramsgate only.
- 34 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Canterbury West services, will not call at Pluckley and will terminate at Ashford International.

- 49 minutes past the hour Margate to St Pancras International via Canterbury West services, will start from Minster at 07 minutes past the hour, calling as scheduled. A replacement bus service will run from Margate, calling at all stations to Minster.
- 08 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to St Pancras International services, will start from Dover Priory at 45 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled.
- 21 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to St Pancras International via Faversham services, will start from Margate at 32 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled. A replacement bus service will run from Ramsgate, calling at Broadstairs and Margate.
- 53 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to Victoria services, will start from Margate at 05 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled. A replacement bus service will run from Ramsgate, calling at all stations to Margate.
- 42 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to Charing Cross services, will start from Minster at 47 minutes past the hour, and then call as scheduled.
- Train services will depart from Minster at 22 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Ashford International via Dover Priory, where it will attach to the above service to Charing Cross.
- A replacement bus service will run from Ramsgate, calling at Minster only.
- 28 minutes past the hour Dover Priory to Charing Cross services, will start from Ashford International at 02 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled.

C Engineering work is taking place between St Pancras International and Heme Hill on Sunday 29 December

- 26 and 56 minutes past the hour Kentish Town to Rainham Thameslink services, will start from London Bridge at 46 and 16 minutes past the hour, and then run as scheduled.
- 12 and 42 minutes past the hour Blackfriars to Sevenoaks Thameslink services, will start from Victoria at 15 and 45 minutes past the hour, calling at Denmark Hill and then run as scheduled.
- 29 and 59 minutes past the hour Rainham to Kentish Town Thameslink services, will terminate at London Bridge.
- 28 and 58 minutes past the hour Sevenoaks to Blackfriars Thameslink services, will run as scheduled to Denmark Hill and then be diverted to terminate at Victoria.
